Ramblers Orienteering Club

MEET REPORT — Angrignon Park — September 19, 2015

It was another gorgeous day for an orienteering event – at a venue that we were using for the first time. The map was only completed a week-or-so before the meet. **Vladimir Gavrilov** did most of the survey work while I provided a little advice and did the Ocad drawing. The feed-back from members was good, both as to the map and the courses.

Four courses were set.

The shortest, **#1 course**, had 10 controls and was an easy 2½ km. It was intended for beginners, family groups and young people. Three groups of high school students from Collège de Montréal, having been given some intensive instruction from head teacher, Jean-François Gagné, went on to easily complete the course. The fastest was 0:14:47 by Maude Tétreault's team.

The #2, Intermediate course had 13 controls and was set a little deeper into the woods. **Jamie McDonald** dominated this 3.7 km course with a fast 0:37:52.

#3 course was designed as an **Advanced** level run. It was 5.4 km and had 17 control points spread across the whole of the park. The fastest time, 46:19, was recorded by **Anders Berkelund**, a Swedish Orienteer who was here on a brief visit to Montreal. **Jessica Auer** Placed 2nd in 56:20 and also won “*Top woman of the Day*” honours! **Charles Melançon** and **Christian Reid** finished 3rd and 4th. 17 individuals and six groups did the course, plus those who also completed the #4 Course.

The #4 Long-Advanced course used two maps and covered a total distance of 8.5 km. The 16 individuals and 2 groups doing the ‘Long’ first had to complete the #3 course and then were given a second map with an additional 11 controls. **Francis Falardeau** dominated the day with a fast 0:52:05. **Dmitri Golovanov** was 2nd (1:01:15) and **Jeremy Barnes** was 3rd (1:06:32). All three had split times for the #3 course that were faster than **Anders’** run on the same course. Francis’ split was 32:28.

107 participants (67 Starts) took part in the event.

CONGRATULATIONS to everyone who participated. You all did great!
