17th Annual Mount-Royal Score-O — November 1, 2015

This event, with its mass start and 2-hour-maximum format, is an annual favourite amongst Orienteers. On Sunday, in spite of the light rain that fell during part of the race, 180 enthusiasts took part. It's too bad that only a few organizers get to see the often thrilling finishes. This year we witnessed one of the best.

With nearly 45 minutes of the 2 hours left to go, **Francis** ran in to the finish but almost immediately darted off again. He had forgotten #32 at the extreme west edge of the map – 2.75 km (roundtrip) later and he was back, but now in 4th place. In the meantime, another thrilling chase had occurred. **Thomas Kneubühler** and **Tapeo Haarla** came sprinting hard to the Finish but, oh no, Thomas had also overlooked a control and he too darted off to get it. **Tapeo** had won his second Score-O with us! The first was in 2008. (It seems that IATA holds a meeting each year in Montreal in early November and Haarla is a delegate. Another delegate from the UK, **Andy Stott**, also scored well and made our event a truly international one!)

Haarla's time for the 40-control course was 1:21:26. Finishing 2nd and 3rd were **Jake Brennan** (1:28:08) and **Philippe Côté-Jacques** (1:30:08). **Dmitri Golovanov** and **Thomas** were 5th and 6th respectively. Of the 62 men doing the event individually 15 were successful in getting them **all, AND** for the first time ever, a woman achieved the maximum without incurring penalty points. **Jessica Auer** punched all 40 and beat the clock by two seconds – 1:59:58 !! Congratulations to all. Full results are online.

Once again, **Bruce Glen** was the course planner and on Saturday afternoon, he and **Elaine**, put in place the controls and punches, the locations of which were marked on everyone's map. Some controls that were nearest the Start were worth 10 to 15 points each; the others: 20 to 25. Returning late cost 10 points per minute of overtime!

A lot of careful map reading and smart route choices were needed to earn a good score. Competitors were given two minutes prior to "the start" in which to study their map and make crucial route-choice plans. At exactly 10:00 a.m. the start whistle was blown. Everyone dashed off in all directions. The plaza was suddenly very quiet.

In addition to the Individual classes there were 32 groups who took part in the **Teams division**. The pair of **Caroline Barre** and **Hélène Dumais** reached 38 of the 40 controls and led with 575 points. 2nd were two High Schoolers from Collège de Montréal, **Eric Crotty** and **Alexander Chandler**. **Anna Fichman** and son **Leo** were 3rd. Teams from two West Island Scout groups also took part. A considerable number of cegep students from John Abbott and Vanier Colleges took part as Individuals.

A Very Big THANK YOU to the many, many members who helped at the event; foremost among them: Bruce, who designed the course and, with Elaine, put in place all of the controls. Many diligent hands are needed to handle map preparations, registrations, organizing waivers, checking and tallying result cards, as well as picking up the controls after the event.

I hope everyone enjoyed the day along with the challenging Orienteering.
