EVENT REPORT: Ski 'n Snowshoe Orienteering

Bois-de-Liesse Nature Park – February 6, 2011

Two courses were set for ski-orienteering and three for snowshoeing. In planning the courses we were restricted by park rules that require us to stay on trails, avoiding possibilities for building in “short cuts”. The courses were thus on the easy side with only the simplest of route choices offered. No complaints received, though!

The 'shoers surprised us a bit – outnumbering skiers by more than 2:1. The combined participation was 65, boosted by a number of members of the Montreal Outdoors Adventure Club.

There was plenty of snow on the ground but a mild temperature and a bright sun gave some of the skiers waxing problems.

Among the skiers... **David Hunter** from the Empire O Club (NY) was the fastest around the 20 controls of the 12.5 km (probable best route) *LONG* course in 1:09:39, closely followed by **Francis Falardeau**, 1:13:45. **Michael Bole** was 3rd in 1:14:45. 15 skiers did the course.

The *SHORT ski* course (6.1 km, 9 controls) was led by **Derek Horan** in just 0:24:30. **Vladimer Gavrilov** was 2nd and **Yee Fun Wong**, 3rd.

Among the Snowshoers...

The *LONG* was 6.5 km (pbr) and had 14 controls. **Benoit Turcotte** finished it with a fast 0:45:55. **Geoffrey Jones** was 2nd (0:56:10). **Andreas Rutkauskas** and spouse **Jessica Auer** teamed up to place 3rd in 0:59:16.

Mike Creamer took the *MIDDLE snowshoe* 4.7 km course in 0:46:05 and **Derek Horan** and daughter, **Kim** (11) navigated the 4.1 km *SHORT* in 0:37A:32. **Paula Kim** was 2nd in 0:58:05.
