Beaconsfield-Kirkland Street & Mini-park Orienteering Maze

APRIL 17, 2011

Saturday it rained! Saturday night it rained – and it continued to rain all through the night. But at about 9:00 am Sunday morning it stopped!! ...and thankfully throughout the event we had no more of it.

Unfortunately, though the streets had dried off, the impression had been made and many people stayed at home. Too bad, because it turned out to be a great event with lots of route choices and challenge.

Four courses were set.

The SHORT was 3.5 km and had 6 controls. 11-year-old **Dominic Rousseau** found them all and was back in just 26:15. In the 5.3 km SHORT-INTERMEDIATE **Christian Reid** finished in 27:42, with **Aurore Varela** 2nd in 35:22, followed closely by spouse, **Maxime Despots** in 36:00.

The 8.1 km INTERMEDIATE course was led by **Michael Bole** (48:30). 2nd and new to our events was, **Nancy Bourassa** et son mari, **Dominic Deslandes** (53:09). **Vladimir Gavrilov** was 3rd (59:07)

The race-of-the-day was provided by two of our regular 'stars' participating on the 12.0 km LONG Course. **Stephen Novosad** was an early starter at 9:50 am but he was back in just 52 minutes and 2 seconds – that's 4.33 minutes/km. No one was expected to better this time except, perhaps, **Francis Falardeau**. We would have to wait a while to find out because he had started late – at 12:13 pm.

At about 1:03 pm some of us began a watch for Francis. If he wasn't back within 2 minutes Stephen's time would stand up. And, it **was** close. Francis sprinted in with a time of 51 minutes, 11 secs, winning the 12 km (15 controls) by 51 seconds!

While waiting for the outcome, **Stephen** hadn't been idly sitting about. He ran a 2nd course – the 8.1 km #3 in 35:25; then did the #2 in 24:00; and finally, the #1 in 15:16. His total on Sunday: 4 courses, 40 controls, 29 km, in just over two hours.
