Bois-de-Liesse Nature Park – May 13, 2012

Another beautiful day for Orienteering! Skies were sunny and the temperature was just right. 74 people took part, including 9 young children running or walking with their parents.

Because of restrictions imposed by the park, we are obliged to place almost all our controls on trails – there were four exceptions in a section of woods outside the park boundary that were used on the two longer courses.

Competitors were also reminded that we expected them to adhere to the park's **stay-on-trails** rule. No short cuts! Unfortunately! The courses were planned bearing this rule in mind, and so fairness in the competition relied on everyone's compliance.

Fortunately, the park has a lot of interconnecting trails of various types and sizes, including some very new ones intended for winter use by snowshoeing enthusiasts. This considerable network provides us with the opportunity of including route choice options between control locations.

Four courses were set. The LONG, at 6.3 km (probable-best-route distance) and with 17 control points, took **Francis Falardeau** only 42:46 to run around, and not being satisfied with such a short workout, he later ran the #3 Course (unofficially) for a total O-experience of 76½ minutes over 11.3km.

Graham St-Laurent and **Xavier Loutre** placed 2nd and 3rd on the LONG, with times of 0:50:47 and 0:51:44 respectively. **Sarah Wilson** was the top woman.

In the 5.0 km (pbr) Short-ADVANCED event **Jean-Rémi Tessier** registered an excellent time of 0:57:05. **Vladimir Gavrilov** came in 2nd just ahead of **Richard Aronoff**.

There were two easier courses of 3.75 and 2.75 km (pbr). The longer attracted more participants and was led by **Doug Balmer** in 0:26:58. The average time on the course was about one hour.

CONGRATULATIONS to all who did well.
