MEET REPORT: Centennial Park, DDO - September 9, 2012

It was a beautiful day for Orienteering! The sky was sunny. The temperature was warm. 96 adults and teens took part, plus 40 youngsters under 11 years. accompanying their parents.

We set four standard courses, varying in technical difficulty, as well as in length. Competitors on the #4 "Long" had first to complete the 17 controls of Course 3 (4.3 km), after which they received a second map that covered an additional 10 controls and 4.2 km - a total of 8.5 km.

Francis Falardeau finished all of that in just 0:55:51 to easily come first. **Nicolas Barrière** was 2nd in 1:05:44 and **Jake Brennan** 3rd in 1:10:02. **Jessica Auer** was the top lady as well as 5th over-all finisher with a time of 1:21:25. Twenty runners did the course.

Stephane Rousseau led the 16 participants who ran Course 3 with a fast 0:37:25. **Thomas Kneubühler** was very close behind in 0:38:32. Amongst the ladies, **Lina Gavrilova** took top honours, finishing in 1:21:15.

On the #2 Intermediate course the **Florent Vilotte** family of four finished the 4.2 km in 0:52:20. Taking exactly one minute more was **Barbara Schumann**. And running with us for the first time, **Céline Piolot** finished in 1:01:15. She later also did the #3 course. Worthy of note : 15-year old **Andrea Rousseau** and friend **Maude** ran the course in 1:01:50 placing 4th out of 15 participants.

Another newcomer, **Anna Denotkine**, running with her 10-year old son **Leo**, made short work of the #1 course, completing it in just 28 minutes, 45 seconds. There were 19 individuals / groups who did this 2.3 km, 15 controls, "introductory" course.

Congratulations and thanks to Dmitri Golovanov who organized the event, He joins Francis Falardeau and Bruce Glen as recently certified Officials for our Club and the Canadian Orienteering Federation.
