REPORT: Morgan Arboretum event – October 28, 2012

It was one of our biggest meets in years – and fortunately for all who were there, it was a cloudy but dry day – much drier underfoot, thankfully, than in some parts of the Arboretum last year! There was a great turn-out for the event with a considerable number of youths participating. This included several West Island Scout and Guide groups, as well as 35 students from Karen Oljemark's Outdoor Education classes at John Abbott College.

To efficiently accommodate the expected large participation more courses than usual were set, namely three of Intermediate level (#2 courses), and two Short-Easy (#1) courses. This worked well. For our Advanced competitors we had two courses set : #3 was 6 km; #4 was 10 km.

The #4 Long-Advanced used two separate maps. One had first to complete #3 and then were given a second map with 9 more controls and an additional 4 kilometers. (All distances given are straight-line measurements. Participants would actually cover more ground.)

Francis Falardeau was once again the fastest Orienteer present, completing the #4 in 1:20:26. **Dmitri Golovanov** was close behind in 1:25:03, and **Stéphane Rousseau** was 3rd in 1:57:01. **Aurore Varela** topped the ladies entries and was 5th overall with a very creditable 2:05:30 for the challenging 10 km course.

Thomas Kneubühler, still bothered by an ankle injury, restricted himself to doing only the #3 course, which he easily won with a speedy 0:41:12 over the 6 kms. **Bruce Glen** also had a great run (0:53:59) to place 2nd among the 24 entries on the #3.

The two top ladies on #3 finished only a minute apart: **Lesla Muir**, a visitor from Australia, (1:36:38) edged **Sarah Wilson** (1:37:48).

There were 59 'starts' (87 individuals) on the three #2 courses. Tops amongst them were **Tim English** and **Andrew Jefferson**, Scout leaders, who completed the 3.65 km #2-b in 0:51:45. Top lady was **Jennifer O'Connell** (1:06:20). Fastest among the JAC students (men and women) were **Gage Christophory-DeGraaf**, 1:00:00, (Course 2-x) and **Jessica Karam**, 1:14:12, (Course 2-a)

The two Short 'n Easiest courses actually had the fewest participants. **Céline Perier** ran the 2.6 km *1-a* in 0:26:42, while **Pierre Bentkowski**, with son Tarek, 10, did the *1-b* in 0:22:40. The average on these two courses was over 3 times longer...as expected.

There were a lot of members who contributed importantly to the success of the meet. Among them, Gloria and Bruce handled registrations, Jessica and Andreas worked outside doing start timing and control card calculations, Aurore set up the String Course for young kiddies, and Elaine did multiple tasks. Course planning, control placement and finish timing was handled by yours truly. Thanks to all !
