Street & Mini-park O-Maze

Brook Park, Pierrefonds – April 21, 2013

It was a gorgeous day for the first event of the Club's Spring Orienteering season. 121 enthusiasts took part including a few families with young children. The youngest, who was just 5 months of age, apparently insisted on being fed part way around his course before settling back in his pack and allowing mom and dad to get on with their race.

There could have been no such tarrying along the way by runners doing the *Long* course! **Vincent Vionnet**, newly arrived on our O-scene but with considerable experience orienteering in France, completed the 11.1 km course in just 52:10 ... a pace of 4.7 minutes per km. **Thomas Kneubühler** was 2nd, in 0:57:19, and **Philippe Côté-Jacques** came 3rd, only 9 seconds behind Thomas.

The 7.7 km *Middle* distance course attracted the most participants, 33 'starts'. **Evan Haldane** was the clear winner with a time of 39:11. **Christian Reid** was 2nd, finishing in 43:12. **Richard Matthews**, here on a business trip from Perth, Australia, and normally running in the M-60 class at major events, was 3rd in 45:07. **Jessica Auer** was the fastest lady and 4th overall in 46:02.

The *Short* course, which had 28 'starts', was only 3.9 km long—but had 13 controls, a response to youngsters who have told us they enjoy finding lots of flags. Almost everyone on the course completed it in less than one hour with **Chris Cross** registering a speedy 25:40. Many others were close behind.

CONGRATULATIONS to all who participated, and THANKS to those who helped with the meet...especially Gloria (Registration), Bruce and Elaine (timing and control pick-ups) and Lina and grandson, Pavel (control card Checking).

THANKS ALSO to the Pierrefonds-Roxboro Sports et Plein Air, for making the chalet available to us for the day. It is not normally open this early in the season.
