### **Bois-de-Liesse Nature Park – May 5, 2013**

**I**t was a glorious day for an Orienteering meet! Skies were sunny and the temperature was **almost hot**. 92 people took part, including 13 young children who were running, walking or being carried by their parents.

Because of restrictions imposed by the park, we are obliged to place almost all our controls on trails. There were several exceptions in a section of woods outside the park's southern boundary that were used on the two longer courses.

Competitors were also reminded that we expected them to adhere to the park's **stay-on-trails** rule. Unfortunately, no short cuts! The courses were planned bearing this rule in mind, and so fairness in the competition relied on everyone's compliance.

Fortunately, the park has a lot of interconnecting trails of various types and widths, including some very new ones intended for winter use by snowshoeing enthusiasts. This considerable network provides us with the opportunity of including a number of route choice options between checkpoints.

Four courses were set. The LONG ADVANCED was 8.6 km (probable-best-route distance). **Dmitry Golovanov** breezed around the 19 controls on the course in just 50:02. **Ralph Seyfert** took just 38 seconds more, and **David Hunter**, who runs races in the men's 60-64 age class, was 3<sup>rd</sup> in 1:01:59. **Olga Rayda** was the fastest woman in 1:19:53.

In the 5.6 km (pbr) Short-ADVANCED event **Stéphane Côté** edged **Christian Reid** by a mere 4 seconds, winning in 0:36:09. **Nadine Cybulski** was the top woman in 057:05.

There were two easier courses of 4.3 km and 2.8 km (pbr). The shorter one also used a larger scale (1:5000) map for easier reading. Again, there were close finishes. On the longer course: The team led by **Sandy Phillips** edged first-time Orienteer, **Boby Chu** by 2 minutes, 18 secs. In the short/easy Novice course Team **Wen Cui Yang** edged family, **Nathalie Reid**:- 31:42 : 33:00. The average time for those on the course was just under one hour.

**CONGRATULATIONS to all** who participated !

**SPECIAL THANKS** to Bruce & Elaine who hung the majority of the 32 flags used in the event and picked up most of them afterwards. They also assisted with registration and were responsible for 'timing'. Any complaints about the map or the courses will fall to myself.
