EVENT REPORT: Ski 'n Snowshoe Orienteering

Bois-de-Liesse Nature Park – February 16, 2014

The air was crisp, the skies were wonderfully blue and the snow conditions and ski tracks were at their best for our first event of 2014. 3 courses were set for skiers and 3 for those using snowshoes –or just boots.

On the SKI courses... The #3 “LONG”, with 17 controls, had the most participants. **Francis Falardeau** covered the 11.6 km (probable best route) in a fast 0:57:33. Finishing 2nd and 3rd were **Thomas Kneubühler** (1:11:32) and the relatively new-to-Orienteering team of **Michael Chown** and **Cullen Thiessen** (1:12:19). **Janet Findlay**, who competes in the W-60 class (at age-classed events), finished in 5th place with a time of 1:21:37.

The #2 course was an abbreviation of the LONG and had 12 controls along its 7.15 kms). **Dmitri Galovanov** completed it in 0:56:00. **Vlad Gavrilov** finished 2nd in 1:11:45.

Frédéric and **Julie Houle** did the 4.6 km #1 course, with their ‘under-two-years-of-age daughter, Elisa, in just 64 minutes.

In the SNOWSHOE event... The #3 “LONG”, with 12 controls, was won by **Andreas Rutkauskas**, who covered the 5.3 km (pbr) in a quick 0:43:14. Just one minute behind was **Philippe Côté-Jacques**, who had earlier done the #3 Ski-O course. Finishing 3rd was a newly arrived Orienteer from France, **Frédéric Elias**. His time– 0:57:00.

Patrick Fernet topped seven others on the 4.35 km #2 course, finishing in 0:50:31. In 2nd was **Ian Silvester** (0:56:00) and in 3rd : **Mary Ellen Montague** (1:06:00). A team of three, **Marlene**, **Mireille** and **Ugo** did the “SHORT” Snowshoe #1 course in 1:31:30.

Many THANKS to Bruce and Elaine who again set out **all** of the 33 controls AND single-handedly picked them all up after the meet — apparently no other offers of help were made. Perhaps beginning the pick-ups earlier than 2 pm might help?? Registration was managed by Gloria, Elena assisted Elaine with timing and the course designs were made by myself.
