MEET REPORT: Kirkland-Beaconsfield O-Maze – May 4, 2014

Light rain showers were a threat for most of the day but never became too much of a concern for those who participated. Attendance suffered, however. There were only 40 “starts”, comprising 55 people.

Four courses were set, with the longest having 16 controls and being **11.9 km** in length—as measured on the map by a ‘probable best route’ line.

Francis Falardeau once again showed his running ability and map-reading mastery by covering the distance in just 50:10 — that’s 4.2 minutes/km, while keeping track of the many twists and angles of the area’s roads; cutting across mini-parks and through narrow passageways along his selected route.

Philippe Côté-Jacques and **Andreas Rutkauskas** placed 2nd and 3rd respectively, finishing in 56:25 and 57:57. There was a tight race amongst the two women on the course, with **Jessica Auer** edging **Yuliya Klochko** by slightly over one minute.

On the **7.84 km** (pbr) course **Philippe Grangier**, running his first event with us, placed first in 0:39:48. **Christian Reid** was 2nd (43:27). There was another close race between the fastest women on this course with **Olga Rayda** finishing 46 seconds ahead of **Nadine Cybulski**. The ladies were also 3rd and 4th overall.

In the **6.2 km** event, **Ciprian Coman**’s time of 0:38:25 was 50 seconds faster than **Sven Von Fellenberg**, who was 2nd. 3rd was **Vassili Korotkine**. **Marianne Côté-Jacques** finished 4th and was also the fastest woman (42:25) on the course.

The shortest course, **4.3 km** (8 controls) was led by **Christian Reber** (33:40).

The family of **Vladimir Denotkine** and **Anna Fichman**, with son **Leo**, 13, were 2nd (37:42). First-timer, **Christine Owers**, came 3rd in 42:55.
