Bois-de-Liesse Nature Park – May 25, 2014

It was a glorious day for an Orienteering meet! Skies were sunny and the temperature reached its warmest for this year. 114 people took part, including 20 young children who were running, walking or being carried by their parents.

Because of restrictions imposed by the park, we are obliged to place almost all our controls on trails. There were several exceptions in a section of woods outside the park's southern boundary that were used on the two longer courses.

Fortunately, there are a lot of interconnecting trails in the park providing us with the opportunity of including route choice options between controls.

Four courses were set.

The LONG ADVANCED was 8.1 km (probable-best-route distance) and had 19 controls. **Francis Falardeau** flew around it in just 38:23. **Andreas Rutkauskas** was 2nd (45:49), and Alexandre Provost came 3rd (46:44). **Olga Rayda** was fastest woman in 1:26:08. Nineteen ran the course.

The 5.2 km (pbr) Short-ADVANCED easily went to **Canberk Özdemir**. The team of **Renatta Selmidt** and **Sarah Michetti** was second in 1:08:31, followed by **Patrick Fernet** in 1:14:35. **Yee Fun Wong** was top woman in 1:21:49. 17 Orienteers were on the course.

There were two shorter courses: #2 was 4.2 km (pbr) and #1 was 2.8 km. **Charles-Antoine Dupont** set the pace for both, running the Intermediate in 0:42:40 and the Short in 0:26:19. **Marianne Côté-Jacques** finished 2nd on #2 (0:46:20) and 15-year-old **Camille Reid** was the runner-up on the #1. All but 3 completed the 'Short' in less than one hour.
