## **REPORT: Ski & Snowshoe Orienteering** at the **The Morgan Arboretum, March 1, 2015**

**W**e enjoyed a gorgeous day for our second Ski and Snowshoe O-meet this year. The snow conditions were great for both disciplines and once again snowshoers were in the majority, outnumber the langlaufers 39:15.

5 courses were set: three for skiing; 2 for snowshoeing.

### **Skiing Results...**

In the #3 - 10.3 km “**Long-Ski**” event **Francis Falardeau**’s time of 1:08:51 was well ahead of the field. The course consisted of first completing a 4.9 km ski (probable best route) and then continuing on a second map with a 5.4 km loop. **Bruce Glen** was 2<sup>nd</sup> in 1:18:39 and **Anatoly Rayda** (1:27:00) was 3<sup>rd</sup>.

The #2 “**Middle Distance Ski**” (4.9 km, 5c) was won by **Vladimer Gavrilov** in 48 minutes. **Mike Creamer** (0:56:35) and **Paul St-Aubin** (0:56:40) almost shared 2<sup>nd</sup> spot. The top woman was **Maria Elias** (1:22:00).

**Gary Bertleff** was the only participant on the 3.9 km #1 **Short** course which he did in 1:05. He later unofficially skied the #2-Ski in 1:18.

### **In the two SNOWSHOE events...**

**Philippe Côté-Jacques** turned in the strongest run of the day on the #2-LONG course. His time for the 6.8 km, 14 controls, was 1:01:50. **Andreas Rutaszkas** was 2<sup>nd</sup> in 1:12:42 and **Jessica Auer** was 3<sup>rd</sup> – and ‘*Best Woman*’ – in 1:27:45. There were a dozen starts.

The 3.9 km (8c) “**Short-Snowshoe**” had 6 starts, plus 7 more family / team-starts. **Anna Fichman** produced the best time amongst all with an outstanding clocking of 0:55:00. One minute back in 2<sup>nd</sup> spot was **Paulo Sousa**, a visiting student from Brazil where he also participates in Orienteering events.

**Congratulations** to all who participated...either competitively or recreationally.
