TWO REPORTS : Great Day at the Bois-de-Liesse : The Club Takes Major Tech Step

Over one hundred participants took part on May 24 at the Bois-de-Liesse event, about 60% of them being members. **More on the event further down.**

The date also marked the initial application of a major decision and investment by our club – the largest, by far, in our history.

We took our first steps towards instituting an electronic timing system. Actually, it's getting pretty rare in 2015 to find an orienteering club, even in North America, that does not use such a system. But they don't come cheap and they do require a knowledgeable group of persons interested and capable of running it. We are fortunate to have the essential beginnings of such a team in Bruce and Dmitri.

We decided to start with 50 “petals” (the electronic card/dibber that you carry on your finger) and four “stations” – sufficient to do the start and finish timing (only) of competitors on the two advanced courses. Plus two laptop computers. Happily, at their first use, everything worked as expected.

As for the cost, the decision was **not** to go with the rather expensive, though most commonly used ‘SI’ system, but instead to purchase a trial number of pieces of the new SFR system. It has recently been sanctioned by the International O Federation for use at certain major meets in Europe. We can even make the “dibber” parts ourselves, saving even more.

Speaking of money, the club has never in its 46 years of existence written a one thousand dollar cheque before ... and the next one could be 5 times that figure **if/when** we go to the next step of more petals, and stations at all control points. Sunday, May 24th, will be the second time the partial system will be used. If YOU would like to help, I hope we will see you there.

Okay, lets get back to the Bois-de-Liesse meet.

As usual, course planning was hindered by park restrictions that require us to place our controls only on trails, and to stay out of the woods. Nevertheless, there were route choice possibilities and 111 persons, in 66 “starts” enjoyed the day.

Four courses were set.

The **Long-ADVANCED** was 10.2 km (probable-best-route distance). The course had 25 controls and used two maps, including one that covered the Pitfield side of the park. **Francis Falardeau** completed it in just over 57 minutes. **Juno Kim**, visiting from Switzerland, was 2nd in 1:11:53. The next six finishers, led by **Philippe Côté Jacques**, were all tightly packed within 10 minutes of each other. There were 24 ‘starts’ on the course, making it the most popular of the four.

The 6.4 km (pbr), 16c, **Short-ADVANCED** had the second largest number of competitors. **Dmitri Golovanov** posted the lead time of 0:42:22. **Christian Reid** was 2nd in 0:45:07 and Vlad Rayda was 3rd in 0:50:34. Olga Rayda edged Anna Fichman in the Ladies section: 0:59:56 : 1:11:35.
